Topic: Paphiopedulums**

Although Tim teaches middle school kids for a living, one of Tim's passions has always been plants. He began growing orchids as an offshoot from working at Longwood Gardens in Philadelphia just after college. From the very beginning it was all about Paphs, particularly awarded and select clones of historic importance, of which his collection numbers nearly 3000. While Tim loves finding old, rare stepping stones in paph breeding, he also does a little hybridizing, and growing up his "own babies" is a blast. Tim is the youngest accredited judge with the **American Orchid Society**, and has served in various capacities with various orchid societies in California and on the East Coast.

He loves meeting other people who like orchids too, and doing so often finds him traveling to shows, vendors, and peoples' greenhouses to see the latest and greatest in new hybrids and to get the best orchid gossip. Tim likes to be involved in plants as much as possible; in addition to Longwood, he has worked at the **Smithsonian Institution** tending to their orchids, and for years for the **United States National Arboretum**, collecting rare plants and documenting cultivated species and hybrids for their herbarium. In short, he really likes plants! Tim will be sharing a presentation on Paphiopedulums.

‘FALL for ORCHIDS’ will be presented November 21–22 by the Triangle Orchid Society and Sarah P. Duke Gardens. The show has been approved for American Orchid Society judging. Advance reservation of exhibit space is now being accepted for those wishing to participate. ‘Fall for Orchids’ will be held at the Doris Duke Center, 420 Anderson Street, Durham, North Carolina.

Setup of the show will be Thursday, November 19, from 9:00 am until 4:30 pm. Lunch will be provided for all exhibitors and show personnel at the show site on Thursday. The show schedule, rules, and additional information about registration of plants will be sent after you reserve exhibit space. Parking passes will be issued to participants for Thursday setup. Judging will be Friday, November 20. Parking passes and lunch will be provided for judges and clerks on Friday. Takedown will be 4-6 pm Sunday, November 22, immediately after the show closes.

A Duke Gardens Members Only Event will be held at the Show from 6-9 pm, Friday, November 20. The Show will be open to the public 10 am - 5pm, Saturday, November 21, and 12-4 pm, Sunday, November 22. Admission to the Orchid Show will be free, but Duke Gardens Parking Fees will apply. Talks by orchid experts, vendor sales, and potting workshops will occur both Saturday and Sunday.

All exhibits will be on tables unless you file a special request for floor exhibit space by October 21, 2015. Duke Gardens has eight foot long tables rather than the six foot tables usually used at orchid shows. We are offering 20, 30, or 40 square feet of rectangular table space. Reasonable effort will be made to accommodate all advance requests for space or table configurations.
