ATTENTION: Plants Needed for Triad Show

We will need lots of plants for our show at the end of the month. If you have plants and/or foliage that you would let us borrow for our exhibit, you can bring them by the Garden Council building on February 26 between 4 and 6 or on Thursday morning, February 27 between 9 and noon. If you bring foliage plants please put your name on the pot. We need all sizes of foliage plants. The only restriction is no flowers on the foliage plants.

Please send a list of your orchids to Janette (jaharris@surry.net) before 7:00 on Wednesday. We try to register all of the plants and print name tags using the computer and printer on Wednesday evening. This helps speed things up when putting the exhibit together and it looks much neater with the printed name tags. This is the information we will need for registration:

1. Name of plant. If it is an unregistered hybrid, the names of the parents.

2. For cattleya hybrids:

size of the flower (less than 4 inches or more than 4 inches)

color of the flower

3. For paphiopedilums:

color of the pouch and petals

4. For phalaenopsis:

color of flower

are there any markings on the flowers (stripes, spots, blotches)

are the flowers small and the inflorescence branched or are they rather large (greater than 2 inches) and the inflorescence is not branched

5. For cymbidiums:

is the plants considered a standard cymbidium or a miniature cymbidium

If you have any questions about registering the plants, please contact me and I will help you. Many thanks for your help and for the use of your plants.
