September Speaker Clark Riley **Topic - Home Orchid Growing, You Can Do It**

Clark Riley has been an active orchid grower since 1957. At the age of six, he got his first plant, a [probably collected] *Cypripedium pubescens* from a perennial nursery. The plant died a miserable death in a short time, but not before blooming and cementing a love of orchids that has lasted over half a century. He has labored ever since to make amends by promoting the sound cultivation of *Cypripedia*. He grows a wide range of orchids, including several thousand terrestrials, hardy species, and ladyslippers, Brazilian *Laelias*, and specialty *Phalaenopsis*, often from seed. He was the producer for the book and CD of *Proceeding of the North American Native Terrestrial Orchid Conference*. He is a member of the Maryland Orchid Society, the American Orchid Society, the International *Phalaenopsis* Alliance, and a frequent contributor to the *Orchid List Digest*. 

Setup of the show: Thursday, November 19, from 9:00 am until 4:30 pm.
Lunch: will be provided for all exhibitors and show personnel at the show site on Thursday.
Parking passes: will be issued to participants for Thursday setup.

The show schedule, rules, and additional information about registration of plants will be sent after you reserve exhibit space.

Judging: Friday, November 20.
Parking passes and lunch: will be provided for judges and clerks on Friday.

Takedown: will be 4-6 pm Sunday, November 22, immediately after the show closes.

A Duke Gardens Members Only Event: will be held at the Show from 6-9 pm, Friday, November 20.

The Show will be open to the public: 10 am - 5pm, Saturday, November 21, and 12-4 pm, Sunday, November 22.

Parking: Duke Gardens Parking Fees will apply.

Talks by orchid experts, vendor sales, and potting workshops will occur both Saturday and Sunday.

All exhibits will be on tables unless you file a special request for floor exhibit space by October 21, 2015. Duke Gardens has eight foot long tables rather than the six foot tables usually used at orchid shows. We are offering 20, 30, or 40 square feet of rectangular table space. Reasonable effort will be made to accommodate all advance requests for space or table configurations.
