Speaker: Ben Belton

Topic: Novelty Phalaenopsis

Ben was born in Mt Airy, NC and grew up in Badin, NC near Charlotte. He attended Appalachian State University and Campbell University receiving his Doctor of Pharmacy degree in 2005. He is a pharmacist at UNC Rex hospital in Raleigh. Ben has been growing orchids since 2005, starting with Oncidiums.

He originally thought Phalaenopsis were boring and round, but has almost exclusively kept Phals since he discovered novelties. He has done some hybridizing and does his own lab work.
